RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Garrison Forest School Horse Show is operated in accordance with the current rules of The Howard County Horse Show Association.
2. All ages as of December 1st of the previous year.
3. The Junior Achievement Award Benefit Hack- Open to all riders, members, non-members, professional and amateurs. Entry fees are used towards \$2500 scholarship to be awarded to an outstanding HCHSA Junior scholar/equestrian at annual awards banquet. Year-end awards are offered to the member horse/rider combination that accumulates the most points in this class.
4. Proper riding attire required. All riders must wear approved protective headgear as stated in the USEF rules with harness fastened while mounted.
5. All stallions are barred from the grounds.
6. All entries must present a current negative coggins, dated within 12 months of show date to show office.
7. All ponies must possess a valid measurement card on file with the association secretary.
8. Six ribbons awarded in each class. Three entries are necessary to fill a performance class. Championships will be awarded in divisions with three or more entries.
9. Classes run simultaneously please advise the gate if you have a conflict prior to the start of the class.
10. Garrison Forest School reserves the right to cancel or combine classes with insufficient entries or to refuse any entry.
11. Garrison Forest School is a Smoke Free Campus. If you must smoke please stay inside your vehicle. Thank You.
12. Dogs should stay at home.
13. No schooling of cross country jumps.

Jumper Rules:

Timed First Jump Off The first round and first jump off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. If a competitor will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jump off in which time will decide in the event of equality of faults. **Timed First Round** The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time allowed. Horses with clean rounds or equal faults are classified according to their time taken to complete the course.
