1. Entry fees \$12.00 per class; Grounds fees \$5.00 per entry.
2. All ages as of December 1st of the previous year.
3. Six ribbons awarded in all classes. Champion/Reserve Ribbons in all divisions.
4. Proof of negative coggins required within 12 months.
5. This show will enforce the AHSA helmet rule for junior riders.
6. Cross entering is permitted according to the 2009 Rules. **CHECK THE 2009 HCHSA RULES for new rules/changes.**
7. The management has the right to cancel or combine classes with insufficient entries.
8. Food will be available on the grounds.
9. **TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR HCHSA CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS AND YEAR-END AWARDS IN A HUNTER DIVISION, AN ANIMAL MUST ENTER AND COMPLETE THE COURSE IN AT LEAST ONE OVER FENCES CLASS.**
10. All ponies must have a valid Measurement Card or be measured prior to their class.
11. No dogs allowed on the show grounds.
12. Every entry shall constitute an agreement that the person making it, along with lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider and the horse (1) shall be subject to the rules of the association and the local rules of the show; (2) that each rider is eligible as entered; (3) that the owner and any of his representatives are bound by the rules of the HCHSA and the show will accept as final the decision of the hearing committee on any questions arising under said rules and agree to hold the show, HCHSA, it's officials, directors, employees and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show, whether or not such injuries or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent act or omission of said officials, directors, employees or agents of the HCHSA or show.

Open schooling in all rings until 8:15 a.m. DO NOT raise or lower jumps during the schooling session.
