Every entry shall constitute an agreement that the person making it, along with the leasee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider, and the horse: (1) shall be subject to rules of the Association and the local rules of the show; (2) that every rider is eligible as entered; (3) that the owner and any of his representatives are bound by the rules of the H.C.H.S.A. and the show and will accept as final the decision of the Hearing committee on any question arising under said rules and agree to hold the show, the H.C.H.S.A., their officials, directors, employees, and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show, whether or not such injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees, or agents of the H.C.H.S.A. or show.

Rules and Regulations

1. Entry Fee \$12.00 per hchsa class.
2. All ages as of Dec. 1 of the previous year.
3. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes. Champion and reserve ribbons in all divisions.
4. Proof of negative coggins within 12 months
5. AHSA Helmet rule for Juniors enforced.
6. Cross entering permitted according to the 2009 HCHSA rules.
7. Food will be available.
8. The management reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes or divisions with insufficient entries.
9. To be eligible for championship points and year-end awards, in a hunter division, a horse or pony must enter and complete the course in at least one (1) over fences class.
10. All ponies must have a current measurement card or be measured prior to their classes.

Timed first jump-off The first round and first jump-off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. If a competitor has gone clean in the first round, the competitor will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jump-off course. If there are no clean rounds and a tie exists for first place, there will be one jump-off in which time will decide in the event of equality of faults.
Timed first round The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. Horses with clean rounds or equal faults are classified according to their time taken to complete the course.

***Warm-Up will have no ribbons and cost \$10.00 per trip. Judge will hold cards for warm-up during show. Rider must declare intention to do Warm-up before they enter the ring. Otherwise the round will be judged and counted!**
