RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. This show is run under HCHSA rules.
2. All ages as of December 1st of the previous year.
3. All horses must be accompanied by a record of a negative Equine Infectious Anemia (Coggins) test within the last 12 months. All equine exhibitors must fill out a **Self Certification of Equine Health** form prior to loading animals, and shall be presented upon request to the designated fair and show representative. Go to the MD Department of Agriculture website, www.mda.state.md.us, for current health regulations and a copy of the **Self Certification of Equine Health** form.
4. Cross entering is permitted according to 2009 rules.
5. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes.
6. All ponies must have current measurement card.
7. Every entry shall constitute an agreement that the person making it, along with lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider and the horse (1) shall be subject to the rules of the association and the local rules of the show; (2) that each rider is eligible as entered; (3) that the owner and any of his representatives are bound by the rules of the HCHSA and the show will accept as final the decision of the hearing committee on any questions arising under said rules and agree to hold the show, HCHSA, its officials, directors, employees and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show, whether or not such injuries or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent act or omission of said officials, directors, employees or agents of the HCHSA or show.

DIVISION RESTRICTIONS

- Leadline:** Open to riders 7 and under as of December 1st of the previous year. Mounts not to exceed 14.2 hands. To be judged on suitability and control of mount. No martingales. Not eligible for any other division at that show except Mini Stirrup.
- Mini Stirrup:** Open to riders 8 and under as of December 1st of the previous year. Mounts not to exceed 14.2 hands. To be judged on suitability and control of mount. No martingales. Not eligible for any other division at that show except Leadline and Short Stirrup (rider must adhere to age restrictions in those divisions).
- Short Stirrup:** Open to riders 10 and under as of December 1st of the previous year. Mounts not to exceed 14.2 hands. Judged on seat, hands, guidance, and control. Fences not to exceed 18". Riders not eligible for any other division at that show except Children's Pleasure Horse and Pony and Low Pony.
- Long Stirrup:** Open to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the previous year. Open to horses and ponies. Judged on seat, hands, guidance, and control. Fences not to exceed 2'. Rider not eligible for any other division at that show except Children's Pleasure Horse/Pony, Children's Hunter and Low Pony. Riders may not show in the Medal Class.
- Children's Pleasure:** Open to horses and ponies of any breed suitable for English riding. Good manners are essential, both in executing the gaits, and while lined up in the ring. No Martingales. Fences not to exceed 2'. Horse and

rider
combination may not jump higher than 2'6" at the same horse show, and may not show in the Medal Class.
